



# HOW TO GET TO BOLSENA

## 0 - by airplane

the closest airports are:

- Rome Fiumicino
- Rome Ciampino
- Perugia
- Pisa

From any of this town you can take a train and then a bus to reach Bolsena. See point 1.

## 1 - By train + bus

Check the Trenitalia web site [www.trenitalia.com](http://www.trenitalia.com) and find train to the Station of **(1.A) Orvieto** or of **(1.B) Viterbo**

### 1.A From Orvieto

take the ATC bus line 52; there are two bus running every day except on Sunday

From Orvieto Station to Bolsena

- 13:20
- 18:10

From Bolsena to Orvieto Station

- 6:45
- 17:00

From Porta Romana Station take a shuttle to Porta Fiorentina Station (it shall run in correspondence to the arrival of the train)

Once in Porta Fiorentina Station, take any bus passing through Bolsena.

The departure time from the Bus station in Porta Fiorentina is few minutes after the departure time from bus deposit here printed:

- 8:00

Bolsena is on via Cassia Bis. You can easily get on the road from Rome or from Siena.

In alternative, you can drive along the Aurelia by the Tirreno Sea and exit at Montalto di Castro, following for Canino, Valentano, then Bolsena

You can also take the A1 and exit at Orvieto; follow the directions from the highway station.
